

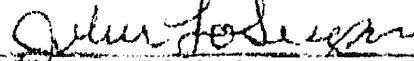
2. The State and the Receiver have agreed to a continuance in this matter based on the following conditions and agreements with Defendants through their counsel, Mr. LaGrappe:

- a. The Temporary Injunction Order and Order Appointing Permanent Receiver entered on February 26, 2009 shall continue in full force and effect until the trial of this matter.
- b. Defendant Howard Glenn Judah, Jr. shall appear for deposition at a time and place agreed upon by the parties which shall be no later than May 15, 2009, and
- c. Defendants agree to the court's entry of an order imposing a constructive trust over the property in the Receiver's possession for the sole benefit of the individuals whom the Court determines at a later date are holders of allowed claims against National Life Settlements, LLC, a Texas Limited Liability Company, National Life Settlements, LLC, a Colorado Limited Liability Company, NATT, LLC, a Texas Limited Liability Company, Howard Glenn Judah, Jr., or Gregory F. Jablonski a.k.a. Gregory F. Joblonski as later determined by the Court.

3. No harm will result from delaying the trial of this case inasmuch as a temporary injunction is already in place and a receiver has been appointed for the assets derived from the fraud. This continuance is not sought for delay, but so that justice may be done.

WHEREFORE, the Defendants, the State, and the Receiver respectfully pray that the trial of this cause be continued to a date convenient for the Court; that the Temporary Injunction Order and Order Appointing Permanent Receiver previously entered in this cause be extended until the rescheduled trial date.

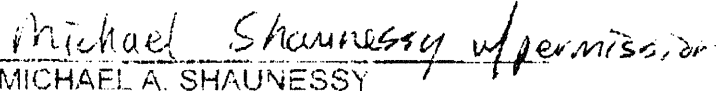
