 - constructive trust over the property in the Receiver's possession for the sole benefit of the individuals whom the Court determines at a later date are holders of allowed claims against National Life Settlements, Li.C., a Texas Limited Liability Company, National Life Settlements, Li.C. a Colorado Limited Liability Company, NATT, LLC, a Texas Limited Liability Company, NATT, LLC, a Texas Limited Liability Company, NATT, LC, a Texas Limited Liability Company, Howard Glenn Judah, Jr., or Gregory F. Jabianski a.ka. Gregory F. Joblonski as later determined by the Court.
